Economic Street - an overview

Economic Street Faith is a financial education programme for churches, helping their members develop the skills needed manage finances and navigate financial pressures.

Currently, there are **8.2m** adults struggling with debt worries. Adults aged 25 - 34 are the group most affected, with **1 in 4** (around 2.1m) of them struggling to keep up with domestic bills and credit obligations.

At Economic Street, we have a special commitment to young adults, more commonly known as *millennials*. We want to see this generation rise to its full potential, unencumbered by the challenging economic landscape and other socio-economic factors.

We believe one of the best indicators of a healthy society is the financial well-being of its people. This course is part of Economic Street's vision to create a finance education hub that empowers ordinary people to live financially free.

Our mission is to provide knowledge and training, enhancing quality of life through financial literacy.

We want to harness the strength that lies within the church: its ability to bring people together, provide an identity, a sense of belonging and a community to call home.

It is an environment that fosters learning and growth, and we want to see this extended to address financial matters, which impact and shape futures. We want to equip saints to manage money wisely and be better prepared for kingdom business.




WHAT WE DO

Our course aims to equip participants with essential knowledge and skills in these key areas of personal finance:

- ⇒ Credit & Debt Management
- ⇒ Saving & Investing
- ⇒ Spending within Income Levels

Through this programme, people learn basics on finance and money; develop practical life skills for better living; and improve social awareness on financial issues that impact their community.



HOW THE COURSE IS RUN

The course covers 3 unique subjects, each tackling a key area of financial knowledge: credit and debt management; saving and investing; and income and spending.

Attendees will participate in case studies, scenarios and group exercises, all designed to boost understanding and increase confidence in handling financial situations.

Qualified instructors tutor the the class and test that participants successfully complete each task.


We rely on money to facilitate key decisions and spend most of our waking hours working for it. Yet we have little understanding of how it really functions and more importantly, how it can serve us effectively.

We adopt a principles-based approach to our teaching, the advantage of this being its practical application to a broad range of circumstances.

We supplement our approach with scenario-based learning, taking participants on an immersive journey that provides guidelines on how to respond to various financial situations that may arise due to both internal and external factors.

Through this programme, participants will become rooted and grounded in the knowledge, values and skills required to become financially capable.



Our programme, **Economic Street Faith**, has been designed to imbibe the fruits of kindness, patience, self-control, joy and peace, characteristics we believe are essential for developing good habits, attitudes and behaviour towards money.

The course makes direct links to Biblical teachings, which can be adapted for use in multi-faith settings.
